Drop Off

Pick UP

- Half day pick up – Front doors
- Full day pick up – Curbside pick up at the front of the school



Tardy POLICY

If you are running late for drop-off and the class has already returned to the room, you will need to walk your child to the office. The office staff will then make sure your child gets to their classroom.



Weekly folder

BIST

St Michael's uses the Behavioral Intervention Support Team model. In order to achieve the "Pyramid of Success," we find it's best to partner with parents.

When a child is struggling, we process with the child by using this 5-step triage

1. Who is in charge?
2. Will you let me be in charge today?
3. What will you do if I give a direction and you don't like it?
(I will do it anyway)
4. What will it look like when you get a direction? (I will be calm and sound calm)
5. How many times will an adult give you a direction? (One time)
