To help families prepare, we have included the information you will need to be ready for the first day of school.

Important Dates:

- July 1-2 – Tuition Invoices distributed via email
- July 12-13 – Used Uniform Sale (after weekend Masses)
- July 15 – Tuition ACH/Payment Due
- August 1 – Class assignments published to PowerSchool/Postcards from classroom teachers distributed
- August 12 – Preschool/Prekindergarten Parent Orientation
- August 14 – Meet & Greet-5PM (school supply drop-off)
- August 19 – 1st Day of School (K-8) – *Noon Dismissal (No EDC)*
- August 20 – 1st Day of Preschool/Prekindergarten

Items to be Submitted Prior to the Start of School:

- Tuition Invoice - Tuition Payment Options:
 - Option 1: Tuition can be paid over 10 months through ACH. *We no longer require separate ACH forms for preschool. Please use one ACH for total invoice amount.*

- *If paying through ACH, any snack fees and registrations fees must be paid separate from tuition.*

- Please return ACH form(s) signed with a blank check by July 15.*

- Option 2: Tuition and required fees can be paid in full (cash or check) by July 15.

- Please note if you have not already paid the \$50 registration fee it is due to the office by July 15.*

- A new Physical Exam and updated immunizations are required by the state for all Kindergarten and 7th grade students. ***The physical exam will need to be completed within six months of the start of school.*** Any physical's completed prior to ***February 19, 2025*** will not be accepted. Physical forms supplied by the doctor's office are acceptable. *All students need to have a physical exam and immunization record on file to complete their health file.*
- Birth certificate, baptismal certificate, and a current immunization record is required for all K-8 students. ***Preschool students will only need immunization records.***

- [Diocesan Immunization Policy Updates](#): Pursuant to Nebraska law, all students enrolling in a public or private school must provide written proof of certain immunizations. (See Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 79-217 through 79-223). Please take time to review the new [Diocesan Immunization Policy](#).

Lunch Information & Reminders:

The school food service program offers an economical and convenient option for school day meals. A full priced meal includes a combination of milk, vegetable, fruit, bread, and meat or other protein rich food. The district receives federal subsidies for each meal it serves that fits that guide. We encourage each student to select three of the five OR all five meal components the first time through the line. Everything selected after that is charged separately.

Federal guidelines do NOT allow the School Lunch Program to operate on credit. If your account is overdrawn, your payment is due immediately. All families participating in the School Lunch Program are required to set up a [MySchoolBucks](#) account. Payment can be made through MyschoolBucks with a \$3.25 credit card transaction fee or sent to the school office by cash or check (made out to St. Michael Catholic School).

Students will never be denied lunch due to insufficient funds. Free and reduced price meals are available to those families who qualify. Applications are available in the school office and on the [school website](#).

In addition, any money that was left over in the school lunch accounts from the 2024-2025 school year will automatically roll over to this coming year.

REMINDER: Outside food may be brought for only the guest’s student(s) and may not be shared with other students. Soda pop and Energy drinks are not allowed.

Volunteer Information:

We count on volunteers for many events including field trips and class parties. Diocesan Safe Environment training must be completed every year and the background checks are good for five years. There is a different training video for those who do not need a background check.
