## Why participate in the School Bank???

It is going to be a **FUN**, educational activity that we hope every student will be involved in!

Just by bringing \$1 or more on as many of the bank Tuesdays as possible, your child will:

- **See a part of a unifying activity for the entire school**
- \* Receive fun **prizes, candy, stickers**, etc. for consistently making deposits
- Earn additional incentives for their class and themselves through regular participation
- ❖ **Diversify** their financial portfolio. It is great to have multiple accounts!
- ❖ Build virtue through consistent regular saving and donating to those in need
- Have a more concrete and personal understanding of how a bank works

### So many benefits for such a small level of commitment!

#### **Participation Requirements**

- ✓ Turn in a signed parent permission form (see back side). It can be done anytime during the year.
- ✓ Each deposit must be at least \$1 in any combination of the following: currency, coin, or check
- ✓ Keep what is to be deposited in the bank separate from a donation to the St. Vincent DePaul Society. Put everything that is to be **deposited** into a single envelope or zip lock bag. Put money that is to be **donated** into its own envelope or zip lock bag. The following must be clearly written on the front:
  - The word BANK or DONATION
  - o First and Last name of student

(you do not need to write the amount)

Classroom (ex: 4A)

#### **Pro Tips**

To get the maximum benefit of the program, students should make a deposit on every Tuesday deposit day.

Coins need to be in a zip lock bag, so they do not fall out of something like an envelope.

On a student's first deposit, it would be good if it is at least \$5 because Midwest Bank will match the deposit **up to** \$5. They will only match a student's deposit the **first time** a student makes a deposit no matter when during the year that first deposit is. Also, Fr. Borowiak will be giving each student \$1 on their first deposit.

Taylor participation to fit what you feel is important for your family. You could have your child earn the money. Maybe when your child receives money for whatever reason, have them put some aside separately for saving, for a donation, and for the children's collection basket at Mass for the church.

The grade with the best participation in making deposits on the first bank deposit day will receive a special reward! (ex: non-uniform day, extra recess, etc.)
