New Dismissal Procedure

Good Afternoon St. Michael Families,

Some friendly reminders for arrival and dismissal: During arrival, please follow the hand signals of staff as they direct traffic.

In an effort to make the last name A-M dismissal line more efficient, we would like to implement the following change beginning on Monday October 31st. Going forward, we will load students at the front of the pick-up line only. We believe by keeping the students closer together; not lined up along the entire curb, we will be able to more quickly get students into their vehicles.

For safety reasons, we respectfully ask that during arrival and dismissal you do not park in any lots to drop off or pick up your children. We have had multiple students run across dismissal traffic lanes to get to parked vehicles. Again for the safety of all our students, please use the designated dismissal lines.

We understand some families have little ones who require help with unbuckling and buckling at arrival and dismissal, we will do our best to help them exit and enter your vehicles.






