

A Note from our Registrar

Pre-enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year for Creschool and Kindergeren only will open for current St. Michael School families and St. Michael employees on <u>November</u> <u>2</u> (The school office is closed November 1 in observance of All Saints Day). In order to reserve a spot in our Preschool and/or Kindergarten program(s), you will need to return the enrollment form(s), along with a non-refundable \$50 registration fee (per child) to the school office. *You can pay the registration fee and access all the enrollment forms via our website beginning November 2*. Please note, we are unable to reserve placement without the payment and pre-enrollment form.

If you will have a Preschool student and a Kindergarten student for the 2024-2025, please be sure to complete the correct form for each student.

As a St. Michael Catholic Church and School community, we will do our best to meet the needs of all families who desire a Catholic education for their children. Space and classroom size realities exist, and when other solutions have been exhausted, the following guidelines will be used to determine enrollment and allow us to plan accordingly.

November 2 – Pre-enrollment opens to St. Michael School Families and Employees December 1 – Pre-enrollment opens to St. Michael Parishioners January 1 – Pre-enrollment opens to the public
